## SQL DDL and DML CS349, Spring 2001, Assignment 4 Due: Monday, April 9th Scott D. Anderson

This assignment is in two parts: writing queries and actually creating database objects and querying them.

For part one, please do exercises 5.1 and 5.2 at the end of chapter 5.

For part two, you will create a username/password for yourself in Oracle, using an appropriate role, then you will create some tables, insert data, and queries on that data. More on this on Monday.

- Create a user for yourself using your firstclass username or something like that (we don't want any collisions). Choose any password you like.
- Create the tables necessary for exercise 5.1
- Insert enough data so that you can test the queries.
- Write the queries and ensure that they are correct.

Hand in your transcript (log) of the queries so that I can see that they work. You can edit the transcript for brevity.
