HW2: Interactive STEM Passport

In this team assignment you will **work with a partner** (who is not on your project team). You will use HTML5, CSS, and JavaScript to implement a simple interactive mobile interface called STEM Passport.

STEM Passport is a web app that provides information about a distinguished woman scientist (or technologist). It should present a name, date of birth, scientific field, major accomplishments, picture (or drawing), home country and major countries (or cities) of activity.

Your user interface should include at list 4 **different pages** and **at least 5 interactive features**. For example, your user interface could include buttons, sliders, images, a dialog box, a text field, and a combo box. In addition, your interface should include **a Google Map**.

The webapp should be styled and behave like a native app. That means that it should open all links within the app, and when possible apply the iOS look and feel. In addition your interface design should apply at least some of the **8** golden rules. For this assignment, you should not use jQuery Mobile.
